

## Training Options

**DV101:** 24 hours of basic domestic violence education. This class meets for 3 hours, on Mondays and Thursdays for 4 weeks. Offered from 12-3pm or 6-9pm (flexible to mix and match day/evening classes). This training option costs: \$200

**DV201:** 40 hours of basic and intermediate domestic violence education. Meets WAC training requirements for domestic violence advocates. Participants **will attend all DV101 classes and continue in-depth learning for an extra 4 weeks**. DV201 classes will continue to be offered on Mondays and Thursdays, but classes will only meet for 2 hours each (12-2pm or 6-8pm). This training option costs: \$260

**DV201-V:** 50 hours of basic and intermediate training, plus topics specific to direct-service volunteering with DAWN. Volunteers will attend all DV101 and DV201 classes, in addition to an extra hour at the end of all DV201 classes for in-depth volunteer learning (12-3pm or 6-9pm). Volunteers will also have an additional 2 hours of a wrap-up and graduation (Date/Time TBD). If you wish to volunteer, the training is free and we request a one year commitment to volunteering an average of 3-4 hours/week.

**Individual Class:** You can attend individual classes at a cost of \$35 per class. Please complete a registration form and indicate the individual classes you will attend.
